French Curve or Curve/Square Ruler (available at fabric stores)

Pencil and eraser

Duct tape or packing tape

Three pieces of posterboard

Sunday, January 18: Gown Draping Workshop

Participants will see a gown being draped on a volunteer, and will pair off and begin draping a gown of their own to take home and finish.

Materials:

Stays, if you have them; otherwise you may use your posterboard mockups from the previous day's workshop

1 yard of linen for gown's bodice lining 5 yards of 60" wide fabric (linen or wool are recommended) for a robe a l'anglaise, or 7 yards of 60" wide fabric for a sack-backed gown Sewing scissors, needle, thread, pins

Accomodations

Best Western Bedford - 814-623-9006 Located 1-1/4 miles from Old Bedford Village. Price per night \$52.15 plus tax for 1 adult, \$62,16 for 2 adults. These are discounted rates and you must mention Old Bedford Village.

Judy's Motel Bedford - 814-623-9118 Located 1 mile frm Old Bedford Village. Price per night \$31.00 for 1 person, \$38.00 for 2 people plus taxes. These are weekend rates.

Jean Bonnet Tavern - 814-623-2250 An 18th century tavern just outside of Bedford, about 4 miles from Old Bedford Village. Bed & Breakfast type accomodation. Prices are from \$85, \$90, \$100, & \$120 plus taxes per night depending on the room chosen.

Participants are also welcome to use the 18th century log cabins at Old Bedford Village, but be prepared for cold weather. Firewood is available.



Food

Meals will be provided for both Saturday and Sunday for an additional fee of \$20 for one day, or \$30 for two days. There are also a number of restaurants close to Old Bedford Village, ranging from fast food to sit-down dining.
